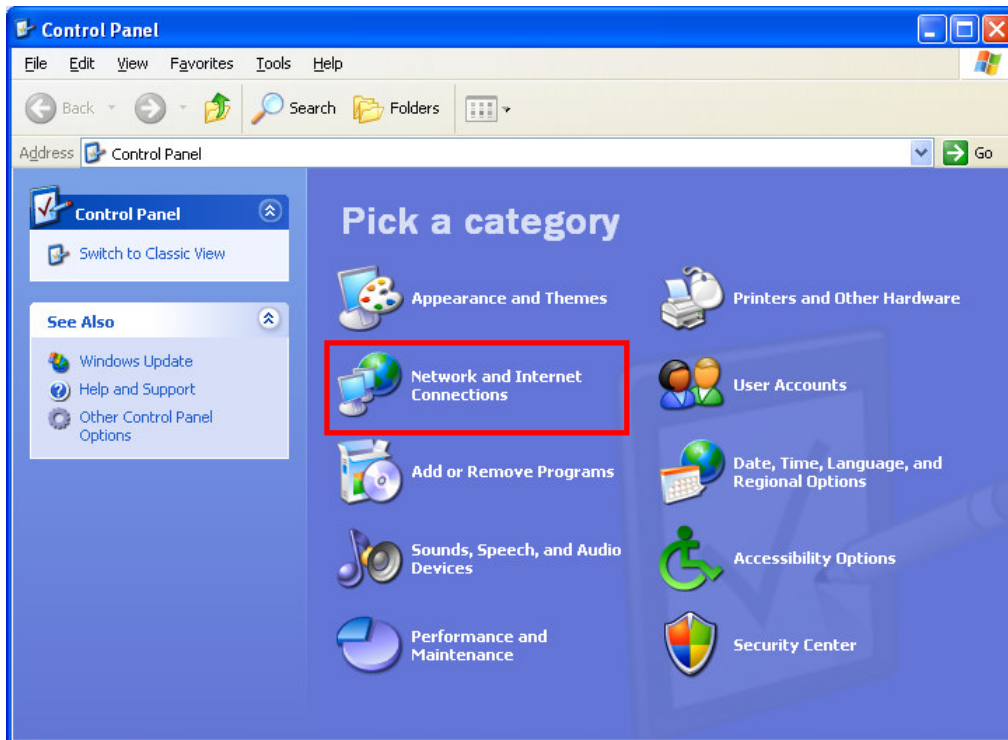


# Configuring PPPOE Service

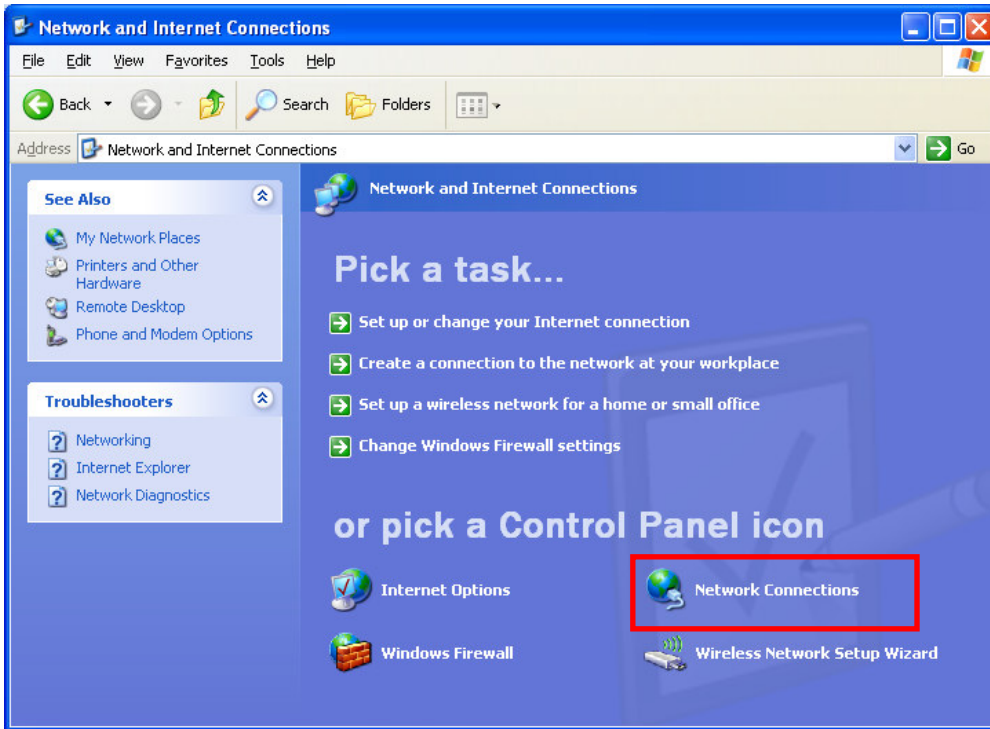
## PPPOE Service – Windows XP

### Setting up PPPOE Service

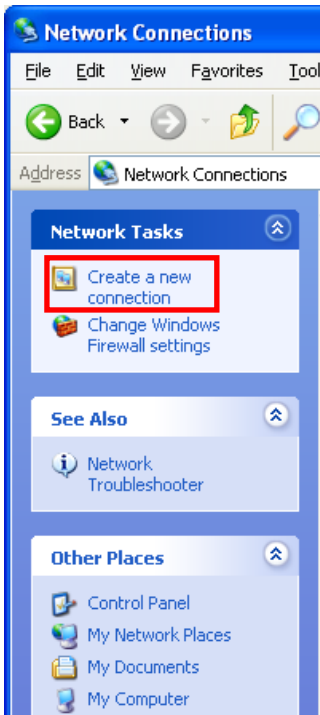
1. Click on **START – ControlPanel**.

3. The following screen may or may not appear. Click on **Network Connections**.



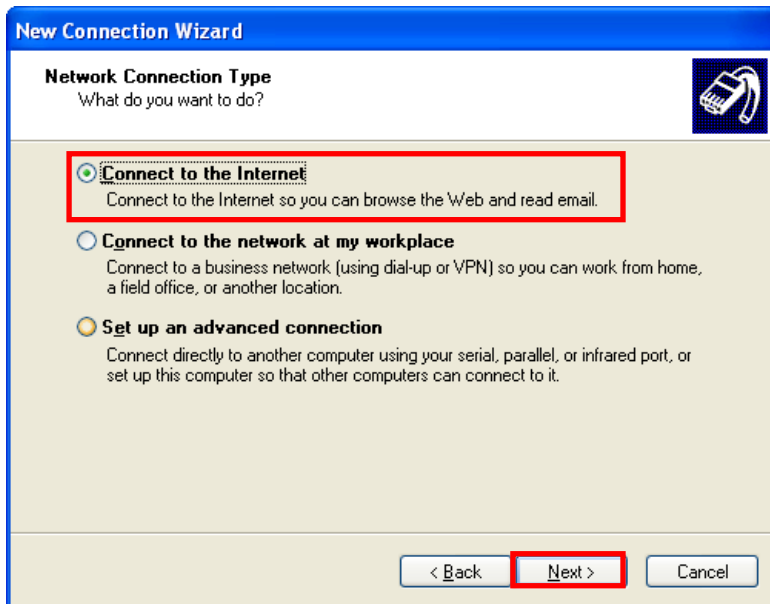
4. The following screen may or may not appear. Click on **Create a new connection**.



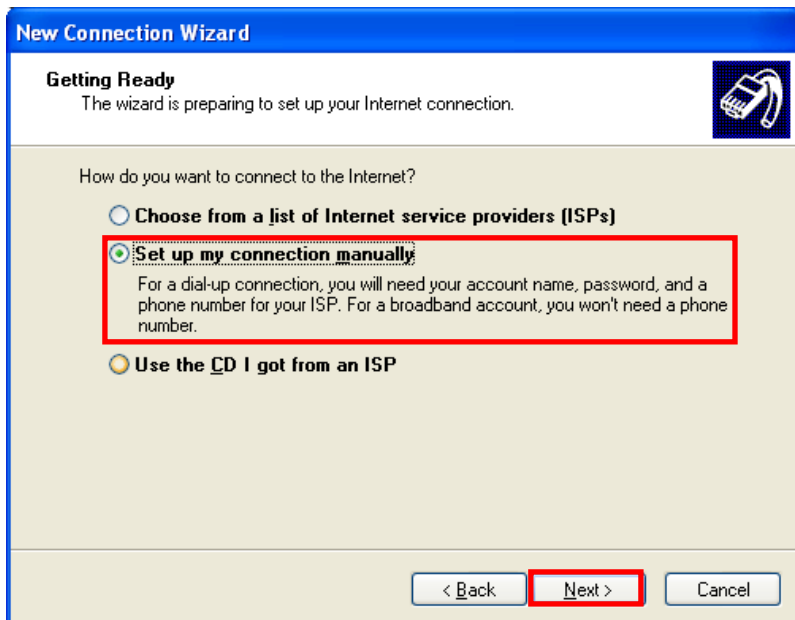
5. The following screen may or may not appear. Click on **Next**.



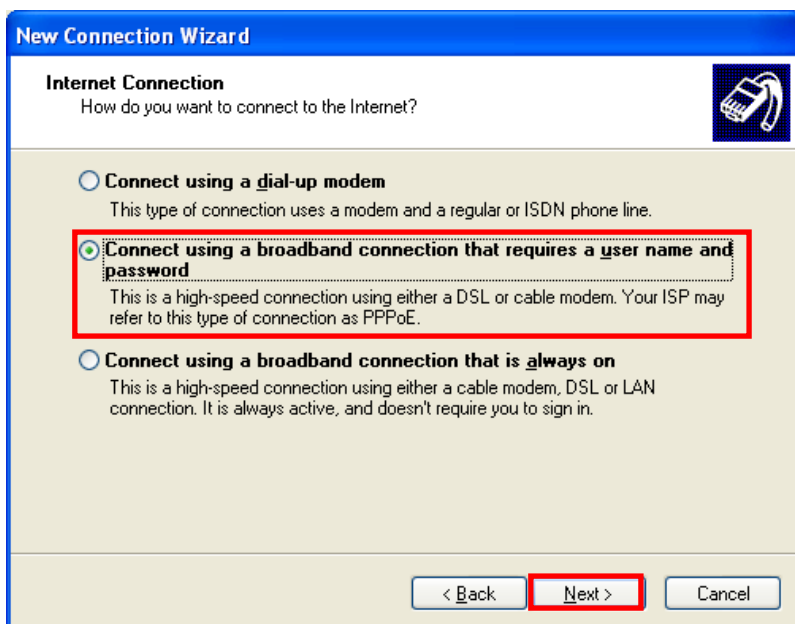
6. The following screen may or may not appear. Select **Connect to the Internet**. Click on **Next**.

8. The following screen may or may not appear. Select **Connect using a broadband connection that requires a user name and password**. Click on **Next**.




9. The following screen may or may not appear. Fill out the ISP Name: **Caylix.com**. Click on **Next**.
