

# Configuring Internet Connection

## *Dialup – Windows Vista*

### Setting up Dialup Connection

1. Click on **START – Network**
2. Click on **Network and Sharing Center**
3. Click on **Set up a connection or a network**
4. Select **Set up a dial-up connection** and click on **Next**
5. Click first on **Dialing Rules** to fill out your location information (step 6). Enter the dial-up phone number, username ([your\\_username@caylix.com](mailto:your_username@caylix.com)) and password, enter the name of the connection (eg. Caylix dial-up connection), select the checkbox **allow other people to use this connection**, then click **connect** (you go to step 7).
6. Select your **country** from the dropdown list, enter your **area code**, select **Tone dialing**, then click **OK**. Finishing now step 5.
7. Windows tests the connection and shows the results. Click on to close the window.

Setting up the dial-up connection is ready now. Click on **START – Connect to**.

1. If it is OK then you see the created dial-up connection. Double click on the dial-up connection shows the screen in step 2. Right click on the connection shows step 3.
2. Enter the username and password and click **Dial**. This connects the computer to the internet.
3. You can edit the settings of the dial-up connection in this window. Click **ok** to close the window.
