

Configuring Internet Connection

Dialup – Windows XP

Setting up Dialup Connection

1. Click on **START - All Programs - Accessories - Communications - New Connection Wizard**.
 2. If the **Location Information** screen appears, select your **country** from the dropdown list, enter your **area code**, select **Tone dialing**, and click **OK**. Otherwise, just continue to the next step.
 3. Click **Next >**.
 4. Choose **Connect to the Internet**, then click **Next >**.
 5. Choose **Setup up my connection manually**, then click **Next >**.
 6. Choose **Connect using a dial-up modem**, then click **Next >**.
 7. In the text box, type: *Caylix Internet*, then click **Next >**.
 8. In the text box, type your **7-digit Local Dialup Number**, then click **Next >**.
 9. If you get a screen now with two options, select **Anyone's Use** and click **Next >**, otherwise just continue to the next step.
 10. Type in your **Caylix Username** and **Password**, and repeat it to confirm. If it is listed, make sure **Turn on Internet Connection Firewall** is NOT selected, then click **Next >**.
 11. Choose whether you want a shortcut on your desktop, then click **Finish**. If your area uses 7-digit dialing you are done. If your area uses 10-digit dialing (most do), then continue to the next step.
 12. Now the **Connect Caylix Internet** screen may appear. (if not, Click on **START - All Programs - Accessories - Communications - Network Connections**, then double-click *Caylix Internet*.)
 13. Click on **Properties**.
 14. Click to put a check in the **Use dialing rules** box, then enter your **Area Code**. Click on **Dialing Rules**.
 15. If the phone number under **Phone number will be dialed as** displays correctly, you are done. If the number displays incorrectly, select the **Location** you want to edit and then click **Edit...**
- **NOTE**** If no location appears, you may have to create a new one. Call it **My Location** and fill out the **Country** and **Area Code** you are currently in.
16. Now, within the screen **Edit Location**, select the **Area Code Rules** tab at the top. Then select your area code and click **Edit...**. If no area codes exist, then click on **New...**
 17. Now enter in your area code, and make sure that the check box **Include the area code**, near the bottom of the screen, is selected
 18. Click **OK**, then **OK**, then **OK**, and you can either close this window or dial up to the Internet if you desire.
